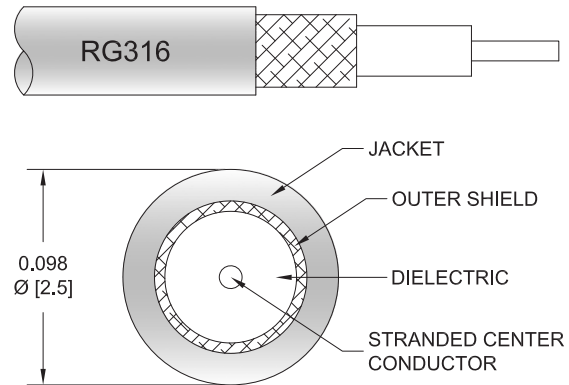

Description

The RA MCX plug to MCX jack cable using RG316, part number FMCA9844, from Fairview Microwave is in-stock and ships same day. This Fairview MCX to MCX cable assembly has a plug to jack gender configuration with 50 ohm RG316. The FMCA9844 MCX plug to MCX jack cable assembly operates to 3 GHz. The right angle MCX interface on the RG316 cable allows for easier connections in tight spaces.

Custom versions of most RF cable assemblies can be built and shipped same day. Custom cable assembly lengths can be obtained by specifying the desired length on the web site at time of order or by contacting a sales representative. Other RF cable assembly value added services including connector orientation or clocking, heat shrink booting and labeling are also available. RF testing can also be performed to document the electrical performance of your cable assembly.
